As a result of the 2000 Census, the Highway Urbanized Area expanded into Walla Walla County. The MPO Boundary was adjusted to encompass this area.

The Tri-Cities Highway Urban Area and Metropolitan Planning Area are consistent except in the unpopulated areas of West Richland north of Red Mountain and in Pasco northeast of US 12.
